Inclusion Support Program

What is the Inclusion Support Program?

The Inclusion Support Program is a team of resource consultants who offer support to children 0-12 years of age.

Children are required to be attending a licensed Childcare Centre or EarlyON Child and Family Centre in the District of Nipissing.

Resource consultants are Registered Early Childhood Educators that are dedicated to promoting inclusive quality supports in all programs in the district.

When to contact us

When an educator, supervisor, parent or guardian has a concern about a child or group, an educator/program will discuss their concern with the resource consultant that supports the program.

The resource consultant will request to see the child's LookSee and/or ASQ and observe the child to understand the concerns being presented.

From this discussion it will be decided what type of service is required.



How does the ISP Program support your program?

Resource consultants focus on the overall growth and development of the child with respect to their physical, social, emotional, communication and cognitive needs and provide case management services.

When the children reach the age of school entry, the resource consultant will provide support to parents or guardians to ensure a smooth transition from early year's programs to Early Learning Kindergarten.

Resource consultants also offer professional learning to build the capacity of Educators in the Nipissing District.
