Inclusive practice is a teaching approach that recognizes a child's diversity and uses this to ensure all children receive equal treatment, opportunities, and respect.

all children and families
regardless of race, gender,
medical, disability, or other
need by eliminating
discrimination and barriers
and giving equal access and
opportunities.



How can I create an inclusive environment?

- By providing programs, activities or physical accommodations that ensure the success of each child.
- Fostering each child's sense of wellbeing and belonging regardless of ability and individual needs.
- Display your program values.
- Educators and Supervisors should work together to reflect on the environment/program and eliminate barriers.
- Observe and document children's behaviour by using tracking sheets and putting strategies in place to support the children.
- Don't compare the progress of one child to another; personal progress is key.
