
## Pedagogical Documentation

Here are 5 examples of Pedagogical Documentation methods that can be used with children:

- **Portfolio** Educator sits down with each child regularly to see which documents to add in the child's portfolio
- Learning Stories write down what the children are doing during the say as authentically as possible.
- **Project wall -** Add all documents related to your project on the 'Project wall'.
- Story crafting Child tells a story and educator writes it down, word for word, as the child tells it.
- Planning Sheet Add what the children have been doing during the week. This gives documentation that you can further reflect on when moving in to the next week.



It is a process of the learning that is taking place, not just a display; Listening to, observing, recording, interpreting, and exhibiting learning experiences;
